Back To (Or Is That From?) Reality

Hartford-born “reality revolutionary” **Robert Galinsky** just returned from Los Angeles, where he was flown to Merv Griffin Productions’ headquarters in Beverly Hills for a series of what he describes as “successful” meetings with **Roy Bank** (president of television for **Merv Griffin** Entertainment) and a number of unnamed networks and cable channels in Hollywood, pitching his New York Reality TV School for a series.

Galinsky — a 1983 Wethersfield High School grad turned actor, casting director, producer and entrepreneur — offers a \$139 three-hour course on how to get on and stay on a reality show, with several students going on to various TV reality shows.
